JANUARY Tuesday 25 <sup>th</sup> – 10.00 am	WEST LANGNEY LEVEL – The repeat of a very successful (if muddy!) walk, looking for wintering duck and other birds. Meet in the small car park on Sevenoaks Road, which is on the South east side of the B2191. Map ref. TQ 625025.
FEBRUARY Thursday 24 <sup>th</sup> – 10.00 am	CHILLEY FARM & PEVENSEY HAVEN – From the farm, across fields to the river, a gentle amble looking at birds and trees. We have permission to park in the Farm Shop car park, please try to share cars. Café and toilets available. Map ref. TQ 638062.
MARCH Tuesday 29 <sup>th</sup> – 10.00 am	HAMPDEN PARK – A popular walk looking at plants, trees and birds, hoping for some early migrants. Meet opposite the Tea Rooms on the road running through the park (Hampden Park Drive) Toilets available.
APRIL Tuesday 26 <sup>th</sup> – 10.00 am	POWDERMILL WOOD – A stream runs through this ancient woodland, providing a varied and fascinating habitat. Meet in the car park off the B2095, Powdermill Lane. Map ref. TQ 734143
MAY Saturday 7 <sup>th</sup> – 10.00 am	BIRDSONG AT BRIDLEGATE – Joe Morley opens his wildlife garden to us. Hopefully nightingales. Tea/coffee and biscuits. No dogs please. Map Ref. TQ 537113.
Tuesday 24 <sup>th</sup> – 10.00 am	HERSTMONCEUX – Starting at the Church, which has some unusual trees, we will walk through the woods and fields, returning past the castle. Park by the Church, at the end of Church Road. Map ref. TQ643102.
JUNE Tuesday 14 <sup>th</sup> – 10.00 am	BOPEEP CAR PARK – A circular walk across downland where with the right weather conditions we should see many plants and butterflies. Map ref. TQ 493051.
JULY Sunday 10 <sup>th</sup> – 10.00 am	LEWES RAILWAY LAND – Much work has been done on this reserve, so we should have a rewarding walk, with many birds and plants. Meet in Car Park off Friars Walk. Map ref. TQ 419101. Toilets available.
SEPTEMBER Tuesday 20 <sup>th</sup> – 10.00 am	ABBOTS WOOD – A walk to see and identify the many different ferns and trees. Meet Abbots Wood Pay and Display Car Park. Toilets available.
OCTOBER Tuesday 25 <sup>th</sup> – 10.00 am	FUNGUS FORAY IN FRISTON FOREST – A different area of the forest from last year. Meet in the Pay and Display Car Park on the Litlington Road. Toilets available. Map ref. TQ 518002
NOVEMBER Thursday 24 <sup>th</sup> – 10.00 am	ARLINGTON RESERVOIR – A walk around the reservoir to look for wintering birds. Meet in the reservoir Car Park (Pay & Display) Toilets available.

**HEALTH AND SAFETY WARNINGS**

Part of the attraction of many wildlife sites is their wild nature. Visitors must be aware of potential hazards. The most obvious are the risks of tripping and slipping, particularly after rain. Beware of water in ditches, ponds, streams and rivers. This can be deep and banks can be steep. Take care if you have to share a path with cattle or sheep. Do not eat or suck wild fruit, fungus, leaves, berries or grasses. Watch out for poorly maintained stiles, overhanging branches and brambles. Clifftops in our area are very dangerous, with sheer drops of many hundreds of feet. Cliff falls are frequent. Keep well away from the edge, and never allow children to run free on, or anywhere near, the clifftop.
